

INTERSTATE PIPELINE CAPACITY SERVICES PROVISION

I. CAPACITY RELEASE SERVICE

Capacity Release Service will be provided by the Company pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Company's upstream interstate pipeline service providers FERC approved tariffs. All capacity release credits received by the Company shall be credited to Account No. 191, Unrecovered Purchased Gas Costs.

II. TITLE ASSIGNMENT SERVICE

A. APPLICABILITY

1. This Title Assignment Service provision shall apply only to natural gas transportation customers with Title Assignment Operating Agreements executed with the Company prior to April 1, 1993, in conjunction with an executed service agreement pursuant to Schedule No. ST-1/NT-1, Transportation of Customer-Secured Natural Gas.

B. CHARACTER OF SERVICE

1. The Company will provide eligible transportation customers access to the Company's upstream pipeline firm transportation capacity and service on the Interstate Pipelines subject to the provisions and limitations set forth in this provision, Schedule No. ST-1/NT-1 and Rule No. 8 of this Nevada Gas Tariff. Upstream pipeline firm transportation service under this provision is available on a recallable basis only.
2. Title Assignment Service shall be recalled by the Company to protect service to Priority 1 and Priority 2 customers in Southern Nevada and Priority 1, 2, and 3 in Northern Nevada pursuant to the provisions of Schedule No. ST-1/NT-1 and Rule No. 8 of this Nevada Gas Tariff, in force majeure conditions which may occur from time to time on the upstream pipeline system, in situations when the recall of Title Assignment Service will result in a reduction in the cost of gas purchased from suppliers and when the Company's core demand for upstream pipeline capacity is greater than the Company's current billing determinant or contract demand on the applicable interstate pipeline(s).

II. TITLE ASSIGNMENT SERVICE (Continued)

C. TERRITORY

Throughout the Company's certificated Nevada Service Areas, except as may hereafter be provided.

D. TERM

1. The minimum term for transportation customers electing service under this provision is one (1) month.
2. The minimum requirement for notice of suspension of Title Assignment Service shall be by written notice from the customer at least one (1) month prior to the start of any calendar month.

E. RATES FOR TITLE ASSIGNMENT SERVICE

Title Assignment customers utilizing service on upstream pipeline transmission systems shall pay the Company monthly, the sum of charges incurred from upstream pipeline systems resulting from quantities transported by the company on behalf of the customer on those upstream pipeline systems during the month.

F. ACCOUNTING FOR TITLE ASSIGNMENT REVENUES

All Reservation Charge revenues received by the Company in providing service under this provision shall be credited to Account No. 191, Unrecovered Purchased Gas Costs.
